125th anniversary of Basisschool Schreuder

In 2021, primary school Schreuder will be 125 years old. The school was founded in 1896 by the Amsterdam pedagogue Schreuder, with the most important starting points: a Christian foundation and attention for each individual child. Due to the entry into the ecumenical AMOS and the relatively small groups, both principles are still valid.

Due to all the restrictions that still apply, we postpone the party week to celebrate the 125th anniversary until the autumn of 2021. The week was planned from 15 March to 19 March. More activities are possible in the autumn, partly due to the vaccinations that have largely taken place by then.





After-school activities

Now that the school has restarted education at school, we are also looking at what options there are for the after-school activities. Because this often concerns activities that have students from different groups together, we postpone the after-school activities for the coming period. We may be able to start up some activities for the last period, mid-April.

Free workshops at Jeugdland in spring break
