Final test group 8

When?

The Central Final Test for Dutch language and arithmetic will be taken on Tuesday 20 and Wednesday 21 April.

Why?

The advice of the final test comes well after the advice of the school. Why then another final test? Because the advice of the final test, given as an objective second, can confirm and substantiate the advice of the school. The final test measures a student's knowledge and skills. While the teacher also considers other aspects such as work attitude and motivation in his or her advice. The school advice of the teacher is the most important. If the final test is higher, the teacher is obliged to reconsider his or her advice and adjust it if necessary. With a lower final test score, the teacher's advice will remain.

Sports day/King's games

The sports day (groups 1 to 5) and the King's Games (groups 6 to 8) are planned on Friday 23 April.

"Together with the schools and sports providers, we do everything we can to give the children - in these uncertain times - a sporty and positive day. It is important to teach children that good exercise is not only



fun, but also important. The form in which the King's Games take place - on a small scale at school or at home - depends on the situation on April 23," said Richard Krajicek, initiator of the King's Games.



Participating schools decide for themselves how they design the day. All participating schools receive tools from the national organization to make it a valuable, positive and appropriate day for the children - in whatever form.

For example, there will be an online exercise program, taste lessons about breakfast and all participating schools will receive a Sports and Party Package, sports and games ideas, an online Activity Package

and a toolkit with concrete tips for organizing the King's Games in the present time.

Before Friday 23 April, together with master Bram and substitute gym master Luciano, we will see how we can design a fun, active King's games / sports day in an adapted way. As soon as more is known about this, we will inform you in a separate email.

Road Works Paulus Potterstraat

Work will start on the Paulus Potterstraat in mid-June. The tram stops at the Rijksmuseum and those close to the school will be relocated. Together they will become one tram stop and will move to a different place in the Paulus Potterstraat. First of all, the trees along this street will be removed and they will 'stay' elsewhere to be replanted later. The actual work will take place in the period from June 28 to mid-November 2021. Corona – current situation

Since February 8, all children are back at school and physical education is again being given. We are so happy with that! The final M-tests are currently being taken to see what effect digital education has had on the children in terms of language, arithmetic and reading comprehension. The results will of course be provided to you and an additional interview will take place where necessary. The performance (as far as the results are known) are generally not disappointing, partly due to the efforts of parents and teachers.

What is particularly striking is that in the field of social-emotional development and school skills (task orientation, cooperation, group formation) a new start was needed among the students. They had, of course, been home from December 14, longer than a summer vacation.

By bringing peace and structure during the school day, children can get used to the school structure again, learn to work together, keep the Peaceful School agreements, work while other children in the class do something else and get back to interacting with classmates.

Despite all the limitations (appointments with parents online, no excursions, no group breaking activities such as creative afternoons and Socrates and staggered break times) we try to make the lesson activities as attractive and interesting as possible. The Museum lessons can now be conducted online and interactively. The opening of Peaceful School takes place in the hall and all classes watch digitally. The same also applies to the Schreudertheater, later this year.



Despite the limitations, a portfolio has nevertheless been compiled, we have continued in the positioning of primary school Schreuder, the choice of a new calculation method is almost ready and we will start with a school-wide WNT week after Easter.

Since the 2nd lockdown, 3 groups have had a day of digital education, due to the quarantine / illness of the teacher: group 7, group 4/5U and group 1/2B. We were able to take care of the other days by substitute teachers. I believe we can be very pleased with that. There are schools, also within AMOS, where the situation is much more challenging. And that is partly thanks to the commitment of you, parents! Because children are indeed kept at home when they have a cold. When in doubt, the school is consulted and parents sometimes have their child tested. Partly because of this attitude and the serious follow-up of the measures (wearing a mouth mask on the square, parents of the higher groups stay behind the “red staple”) we have kept the infection rate low so far. Let's keep this up so that the kids can go to school every day.

Staff

I hereby give you an update on the absent staff members.

- First of all, the nice news: Miss Roos, from group 4 / 5u, gave birth to a very healthy son, Joep! Everything went well and mother and son are doing great!
- Master Bram, the gym master, has started teaching a single gym class as of March. He does this (unfortunately) not yet at Schreuder, but at the other school where he works, the Atlantis. Master Bram does come to school every week to carry out some other activities, so that he keeps in touch with the school. Fortunately, things are going in the right direction.
- Miss Lara, groups 7/8 and 6/7, is still in the initial phase of recovery. There is regular contact with her. For the time being, starting up reintegration is not an option. Fortunately, Miss Brechtje comes in well on Wednesdays and Fridays. We wish Miss Lara much strength and improvement!
- Miss Evelyn, group 5 teacher, is working hard on her recovery. She misses the children very much (and the children miss her). There is also regular contact with her. As soon as the reintegration can start, we will inform the parents of group 5 about this. We also wish Miss Evelyn a lot of strength and improvement.



Head lice

Now that no head lice check can take place at school, the check for head lice can only take place at your home. Would you please check your son / daughter (preferably daily!) for head lice? Use a real lice or nits comb to prevent these bugs from being left behind and spilling over to a classmate's hair.

If the teacher detects head lice on a student, you will be called to pick up your child from school and treat him / her at home. The group will receive an email from the school that head lice has been detected and we will make an urgent request to comb your child extra well.

Teacher supporter

My name Arfa Madarun, I am a teacher supporter at Schreuder Primary School.

Last year I completed the Remedial Teacher training.

As a teacher supporter I perform (lesson) supported tasks and (student) guiding tasks. I do this for students who need extra support for different subjects, from group 1 to group 8.

In addition, I supervise pre-school and early childhood education (VVE) and NT-2 preschoolers who need extra language support to increase their vocabulary.

Plus group supervisor

My name is Cristina Nijhoff. In 2015, in connection with appropriate education, I set up the plus group for groups 1, 2 and 3 at the Poseidon and the Vlinderboom schools. I still enjoy working with the students of the plus group at the Poseidon. From this school year I work at Basisschool Schreuder instead of the Vlinderboom.

At the plus group, attention is paid to dealing with frustration, self-understanding of your own thinking ability and cooperation.

Attention is paid to analytical, critical and creative thinking and the inquiring attitude of the students. There are also extra philosophy and technique lessons.

We also work with brain games. Persistence is central to this. The children work independently or in pairs with a brain game. When they have played the game at least 6 times, they will take their checklist home. They are very proud of that!

Select the Junk mail section on the left and click on Safe senders. 5. Enter the e-mail address mailservice@email.parnassys.net or noreply@parro.com. It has now been added as a trusted sender.

Gmail

The emails from ParnasSys often arrive at Gmail in the main folder Categories, with the subfolder Advertising. If you have opened the ParnasSys mail here, you can move the mail to your inbox and Gmail will see ParnasSys as a safe sender in the future.

Apple address

If you are using an Apple email address, such as @ me.com, @ icloud.com @ mac.com, or another Apple domain, add the address noreply@parro.com for Parro or mailservice@email.parnassys.net for ParnasSys as a safe sender to your mail program. Toddler care - PRE-SCHOOL EDUCATION - LEARNING BY PLAY AT KLEINTJEZUID



KleintjeZuid has started offering toddler care in Schreuder primary school on 1 March 2021 and will be an officially recognized pre-school by mid-April 2021. The pre-school is intended for children from 2 to 4 years old and prepares them in a playful way for the transition to the primary school.

The mornings at the pre-school are all about meeting, playing, crafting, singing, dancing and learning together in a playful way. The group room is located on the ground floor of the school building and is a safe, attractive and carefully decorated space. At the table fruit and bread are eaten together and the children can tinker or do puzzles. In addition, there are various corners where the children can play, such as

a doll corner with a shop, dressing up area and studio.

The pedagogical staff provide fun and educational activities every day that are good for development. The special toddler section of the schoolyard is used daily to get some fresh air and to play exercise games.

The pre-school is open half days from 8.15am to 1.45pm. The children can be picked up from 12.30 pm after having lunch together.

AFTER-SCHOOL CARE - A PARTY EVERY DAY

Last school year, KleintjeZuid started with after-school care at Basisschool Schreuder. Children in primary school age of 4-12 years are taken from school by their regular pedagogical employees, after which they can relax in a homely environment at our after-school care after a busy day at school. In addition to the two group rooms where the children can eat, drink and play games together, there are several play corners and extra play areas where children can enjoy themselves. For example, the children have a studio filled with craft materials, a dressing up area where the imagination can run wild and an extra play area on the first floor where the older children have more freedom of movement and can practice with a little more independence. In the schoolyard, children can move freely with sports and games and the immediate vicinity offers endless possibilities in the field of art and culture.

After-school care is open daily until 6:45 PM. The children can be picked up from 5.30 pm, after they have eaten a healthy hot meal together. Children are welcome all day during school holidays and on study days. Thanks to a great holiday program filled with fun activities, educational workshops and adventurous trips, every day is a party at the after-school care of KleintjeZuid!

At the moment, children can still be registered for after-school care and pre-school.
