Schreudertheater



Wednesday 17 November is the first Schreudertheater of this year.

The children give a presentation on a topic that they are working on in class. This can be storytelling, in the form of a piece of work, a song, a play, crafts, etc.

Sports stimulation

Our school participates in a sports stimulation program of the municipality of Amsterdam. Part of this is the use of a student tracking system about movement. With this letter we inform you about the student tracking system of this sports stimulation programme.



Exercise is important

Our school believes it is important that children exercise sufficiently and that is why we encourage students to participate in sports and exercise activities. We also have a duty under the law to encourage sports and exercise. We work together with the municipality of Amsterdam to organize the sports offer during and after school. In order to organize this properly, it is necessary to map the movement development of the students.

What is the student tracking system?

The pupil tracking system is a digital registration system in which the gym teacher notes the movement development of children from groups 3 to 8. With this data, the gym teacher can see how a child is developing and the gym teacher can offer a suitable sports offer.

What information is in the student tracking system?

Every year a sports interview and exercise tests are taken with the children from group 3 to 8 in order to be able to follow the movement development. The results are recorded in a digital pupil monitoring system. For example, you will be asked:

Whether your child has participated in swimming lessons and obtained the highest swimming diploma

Whether your child is a member of a sports club

Whether your child participates in after-school sports and which sport he/she would like to do

Does the pupil monitoring system comply with the AVG (general data protection regulation)?

Yes. The data is stored in a system that complies with the security guidelines set by the AVG. Only the gym teacher can view the data at the child level. You can view the data at any time if you wish. You can also have the data corrected or deleted. You can make such requests to your child's (gym) teacher. This data is stored in the student tracking system until the student has left school.

Your child's data not in the student tracking system?

Contact your child's (gym) teacher if you do not want the data stored in the student tracking system. If you have no objections, you do not need to respond. If you have objections at a later date that your child's data will be included in the student monitoring system, you can pass this on to your child's (gym) teacher.

Swipp Swapp app

The smell of gingerbread cookies has been in the air for quite some time and Christmas Eve is almost upon us. Everyone goes into fifth gear again to get all the gifts wrapped and in time and that is not always without stress. Swip Swap is the app to swap toys near you. Swapping is done via the Swip Swap app and the Swip Swap exchange spots in the Netherlands. You upload your toys in the app, after which you can meet others from your immediate environment at an exchange spot to redeem your physical exchange. All you need to do as a parent is to download the Swip Swap app! This is not only good for the wallet, but also for the environment. You can also set up your own Swip Swap swap spot and/or swap market, and thus make even more sustainable impact. The more 'swappers' in a neighbourhood, the more people can exchange 'new' toys with each other, and the greater the sustainable exchange movement! This is how we make second-hand first choice.
