### SprookjesWonderland



### Melanie





Last month we received the message below with a school report from 1916, more than a century old, very special!

L.s.

*Bij het opruimen van de inboedel van een reeds lang geleden overleden familielid kwam ik een schoolrapport van "Instituut Schreuder" Jan Luykenstraat 19 te Amsterdam tegen. Het is een Christelijke inrichting voor fröbel-, uitgebreid lager- en voortgezet onderwijs. Het rapport is van 1916/1917 tot en met 1921/1922.*

Parents of our “regular” students will receive a request next month via Social Schools (of the WIS Collect system) for payment of the -voluntary- parental contribution and the –non voluntary-TSO contribution. You can choose to pay in installments.

If your child is in possession of a **Stadspas** you can pay for the *parental contribution* with this pass: you can email the number of the Stadspas to [administratie.schreuder@amosonderwijs.nl](mailto:administratie.schreuder@amosonderwijs.nl), please mention the name and group of your child. You can also visit the administration to have the Stadspas scanned. Could you do this before November 1st? The Stadspas cannot be used for the TSO contribution.
